# REQUIREMENTS

### ENERGY, RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT CONCENTRATION

All students are required to take at least six IR courses:

### OTHER GENERAL SAIS REQUIREMENTS

#### CORE EXAMS

Two core exams are required. Exams may be taken on a “stand-alone” basis (exam only) OR at the end of the course.

must be completed by end of 2nd semester.
- ❑ **Choose** one of the following:

  - American Foreign Policy since World War II
  - Evolution of International Systems
