**JHU CERTIFICATE PROGRAM DISCLOSURE FORM**

**Final regulations published in the Federal Register on October 29, 2010 require that institutions disclose to prospective students certain information for title IV-eligible programs that lead to gainful employment in a recognized occupation (GE Programs). At JHU, these required disclosures for GE Programs pertain to title-IV eligible certificate programs.**
