Global Theory & History | M.A. Requirements

Students concentrating in Global Theory and History must take three (or four) courses identified as GT&H courses. The remaining courses to meet the overall six-course IR requirement must be distributed across at least two other IR programs. Students must either pass the Theories of International Core exam by the end of the second semester or take the IR core course.

International Relations concentrators studying at the Bologna Center must take at least three IR courses in Washington. Exception: those concentrators who are joint-degree students or have advanced standing, must take at least two IR courses in Washington.
