<p>Friday, August 4</p>	<p>Last day for rising 2nd year students to submit primary concentration changes for bidding priority.</p>
<p>Friday, September 1</p>	<p>Deadline for Online Registration for all Non-Language Courses (6:00 PM) - ALL STUDENTS MUST BE REGISTERED</p>
<p>Saturday, September 2</p>	<p>The list of courses that will go to bid in the first round will be posted on this Web site no later than 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 2. Courses eligible to go to bid in round one include foundation economics courses (<i>non-Accelerated Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, International Trade Theory and International Monetary Theory</i>) and a limited number of additional courses per instructor request. (See Bidding Special Rules)</p> <p>Note: Please be advised that all remaining limited enrollment courses that are oversubscribed at the end of the first week are subject to a second round of bidding which runs Monday, September 11 – Tuesday, September 12.</p>
<p>Saturday, September 2– Monday, September 4</p>	<p>First round of bidding opens at approx. 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 2. Students enrolled in courses that go to bid in the first round must bid by 9:00 p.m. on Monday, September 4.</p> <p>Note: Students must check the bidding web site at http://www.sais-jhu.edu/content/registration-and-student-records#bidding-sais-dc to view the list of courses that have gone to bid in round one. Bids will not be accepted once bidding closes at 9:00 p.m. on Monday, September 4.</p>
<p>Tuesday, September 5</p>	<p>First-round bidding results will be distributed to students via their JHU email as follows:</p> <p>7:00am for classes starting at 8:00am</p> <p>All other results will be distributed by 10:00am</p>
<p>Tuesday, September 5– Monday, September 11</p>	<p>Drop/Add online period opens at 10:00 a.m. Students should use this period to obtain course information including sitting in on courses. Courses that went to bid during the first round will be closed to online registration changes. One must be registered by 9pm on Monday, September 11 in order to bid.</p>

	<p>Note: It is recommended that students have an alternate class in mind if they are enrolled in a limited enrollment course that may go to bid. If a student's alternate classes also have limits, you must be registered prior to the close of drop/add to be eligible to bid on those classes. Students may not register for classes that went to bid in Round 1.</p> <p>Note: If you drop one of the courses for which you bid successfully in the first round your bid points will not be returned back. Changes for courses where entry was gained via bidding may be requested by email to SAISbids@jhu.edu.</p>
<p>Monday, September 11</p>	<p>Drop/Add online closes at 8:00 p.m. The list of oversubscribed courses that will go to bid in the second round will be posted on the Bidding website by 10pm on Monday, September 11.</p> <p>Note: Students must check the bidding web site at http://www.sais-jhu.edu/content/registration-and-student-records#bidding-sais-dc to view the list of courses that have gone to bid in round two.</p>
<p>Monday, September 11 – Tuesday, September 12</p>	<p>Second round of bidding begins by 10 p.m. Monday, September 11 and closes at 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 12.</p> <p>Note: Courses that do not go to bid in the first round but are oversubscribed at the end of the first week of classes (Monday, September 11) will go to bid on the second round. All registered students who do not gain automatic entry into these courses will need to bid.</p>
<p>Tuesday, September 12</p>	<p>Second round bidding results will be distributed to students via their JHU email as follows:</p> <p>7:00am for classes starting at 8:00am</p> <p>All other results will be distributed by noon</p> <p>Online Add/Drop will open at 12:00 NOON</p>
