

Report on Course Bidding at SAIS Europe, Spring 2014

Following preliminary registration in December, the status of capped courses was as follows:

Enrollment was made available on January 15 following some changes in the schedule [Renewable Energy class was cancelled; course on European Financial Markets (Jones) and Financial Derivatives and Risk Management (Bajo) added to curriculum].

- This course went to bid. Priority was given to AFP concentrators (5). Bidding for the remaining seats (13) was announced by email to the Classof2014@jhuc.it on Wednesday (Jan. 29). Students were required to be registered for the course by 8 am on Friday Jan. 31 to be eligible to bid. Bidding ran online on the BCWeb from 9 am through 4 pm on Friday. Results were announced by email before 5 pm on Friday afternoon.
