Student and/or Spouse Tax Filer - Verification of 2014 Income

Your 2014–2015 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before disbursing Federal Student Aid, you must confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

WARNING: Anyone purposely give false or misleading information on this worksheet may be fined, be sentenced to prison, or both.

How to Request a 2014 IRS Tax Return Transcript:

Request an IRS Tax Return Transcript online at www.irs.gov. Click on "Order a Return or Account Transcript" link. Request the IRS Tax Return Transcript (not the IRS Tax Account Transcript). A request may also be placed by calling 1-800-908-9946.

Use the Social Security Number and date of birth of the first person listed on the 2014 IRS income tax return and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used on the 2014 IRS income tax return).

If you file your 2014 tax return electronically, the IRS Tax Return Transcript may be requested within 2-3 weeks after your 2014 electronic income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. If you file your 2014 tax return by mail, the IRS Tax Return Transcript may be requested within 8-11 weeks after your 2014 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS.
